SUBJECT: FISCAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION FOR ASSISTANCE

EXPENDITURES UNDER THE CALIFORNIA WORK OPPORTUNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY TO KIDS (CalWORKs) AND TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE TO NEEDY FAMILIES (TANF) BLOCK GRANT PROGRAMS - SAFETY NET

REFERENCE: County Fiscal Letter (CFL) No. 01/02-31, dated September 27, 2001; All-

County Letter (ACL) Nos. 02-66, dated September 3, 2002; 99-90, dated October 21, 1999; and 01-66, dated September 18, 2001; 02-33, dated May 1, 2002; and All-County Information Notice No. I-52-99, dated August 9, 1999

This letter provides claiming instructions for the assistance provided to families in which <u>all</u> adults in the Assistance Unit (AU) have reached the CalWORKs 60-month time limit established by Welfare and Institutions Code Section 11454. Upon reaching the time limit, families are moved into the "Safety Net" where the children continue to be aided. Please refer to ACL No. 02-66, dated September 3, 2002, for program implementation instructions.

Cases that exceed the CalWORKs time limit must be tracked separately to ensure appropriate reporting and funding. The following aid codes have been established for this purpose effective January 1, 2003.

<u>Aid Code 3A:</u> Safety Net - All Other Families, CalWORKs Timed-Out, Child Only Cases All cases categorized as "All Other Families" prior to timing out, including legal non-citizens, in which all adults have reached the CalWORKs 60-month time limit and do not meet a time extender exemption.

<u>Aid Code 3C</u>: Safety Net - Two Parent Families, CalWORKs Timed-Out, Child Only Cases: All cases categorized as two-parent families prior to timing out, in which all adults have reached the CalWORKs 60-month time limit and do not meet a time extender exemption. Includes recent non-citizen two-parent cases.

**Zero-Parent Cases:** Current zero-parent cases/child only cases that are in this category for reasons other than because the adult has reached the CalWORKs time limit should not be considered a Safety Net case. Such cases should continue to be coded to Aid Codes 33, 3G, or 3H, as appropriate.

**Two-Parent Cases**: Current two-parent cases in which only one adult reaches the CalWORKs time limit should not be considered a Safety Net case. Such cases should continue to be coded to Aid Codes 35, 3M, or 3U, as appropriate.

#### **FUNDING**

Consistent with the State Fiscal Year 2002/03 Budget, Safety Net grant payments will be shared at 97.5% State and 2.5% County.

#### **CLAIM FORM CHANGES**

The CA800S (State), currently used for claiming Two Parent Families (Aid Code 35), has been modified to include Safety Net aid codes, 3A and 3C. This form has also been modified to include the Aid Code 32 for TANF timed-out cases which are currently being reported on the CA 800 (FED). Please note that these changes are effective January 1, 2003. Counties should continue reporting Aid Code 32 cases on the CA 800 (FED) through December 31, 2002. A sample revised CA 800S (Rev. 1/03) is provided as Attachment I.

- 3. Check the appropriate box: Safety Net All Families, Safety Net Two-Parent Families, TANF Timed-Out, or Two-Parent Families.
- 4. All amounts on this form may be rounded to the nearest dollar.

#### **CURRENT MONTH**

- 5. Line 1A through Line 5A: Complete with the amounts shown on the integrated payroll summary (for non-integrated payrolls, enter the grand totals shown for each payroll). Only current month adjustments should be entered on Line 5A.
- 6. Line 6B: Enter the subtotal from Lines 1A through 5A.

#### **PRIOR MONTH NEGATIVES**

- 7. Line 7A: Complete with the amounts shown on the integrated payroll summary. (For non-integrated payrolls, enter the grand totals shown for each contra-roll.)
- 8. Line 8A: Enter the total of <u>all cash recovered</u> in this month for aid paid in a prior month. This includes cash abatements or repayments of overpayments received during this report month.
- 9. Line 9A: Enter the totals of all prior month negative adjustments which decrease money amounts that were claimed in a prior month Summary Report.
